Trustee Replogle informed the Board that Krumholtz Brothers Landscaping, Inc. has completed work on the Franklin/Harris project with the exception of any dress-up exterior touches, and will now move to Hannibal Street for that phase.

Replogle also reports that Russell Boston has earned his Class C Water Operators License last week

Trustee Getz moved to transfer \$11,722.04 from General Savings to Police Operations Checking to cover bills and payroll. Zuercher seconded.
