Trustee Scott moved to approve the minutes for the regular meeting of June 3, 2019, and Scranton seconded.

Trustee Scott moved to approve all bills incurred since June 3, 2019, and Scranton seconded.

Regarding possible mold in the police offices, President Bong asked Trustee Scott to contact a company or individual to test the area for mold.

President Bong will contact *Betterment Association* about possible reimbursement for increased police presence at the Turkey Festival.

Trustee Zuercher reported that most of the budget numbers are in, and he will meet with Trustee Harding and Dick Wherry to discuss the 2019-2020 budget.

Trustee Scott moved to transfer \$17,657.64 from General Fund Savings to Police Operations Checking to cover bills and payroll. Scranton seconded.

Eric Hansen was present to update the Board concerning the drainage improvements at the grade school which will entail reconstructing the sidewalk and possibly placing a manhole over the existing storm drain.

Trustee Scranton moved to approve President Bong's appointment of Trustee Harding as Village President Pro Tem through 2019 until May of 2020. Scott seconded.

Trustee Scranton moved to approve **Ordinance 19-107** revising and amending the definition of a Class B liquor license under Chapter 13, Title 11 of the Tremont Village Liquor Code. Scott seconded.

Trustee Harding informed the board that the tentative budget will be ready for review on July 1 and approval July 15.

In final business, Trustee Scranton reported that the motorhome, camper, trailer situation is getting worse in town and needs to be addressed. No action was taken at this time.
